- During the week while Canyon & Eagle Lodge are closed, there will be no access back in that direction. There is NO patrol coverage in these areas.
- Services out of Eagle Lodge for this weekend include rentals, lift tickets, retail and the coffee bar.
- Services out of Canyon Lodge for this weekend include rentals, retail, Naan Stop, and ticket counter on the second floor at Canyon Kids. The Repair shop will be open Friday, Saturday and for pick-ups only until 12pm on Sunday.

City of Bishop Public Announcement

- The City of Bishop and allied agencies have identified potential flooding concerns within the creek corridor at the City Park.
- To allow for maintenance of the creek, the Bishop City Park will have extremely restricted access from May 3-8. Recreation within the central areas of the park will be limited and/or closed to the public and park usage is not advised.
- **Areas including the playgrounds, skate park, rear pavilion, pond gazebo and tennis courts will be restricted during maintenance operations.**
- There will be no access to the core areas of the park from Horace Albright Avenue.
- The City of Bishop in conjunction with additional agencies will be accessing and performing watershed maintenance in preparation for the projected high levels of runoff.

- *“Mental health challenges are one of the most common health conditions in California, and nearly 40 percent of adults in the United States reported struggling with mental health or substance use during the COVID-19 pandemic,”* said Supervisor Rhonda Duggan, Chair of the Mono County Board of Supervisors.
- Mono County urges residents and visitors to be aware of the resources available from the Mono County Behavioral Health Department, including mental health treatment, substance use disorder counseling, community wellness programs, and suicide risk assessment.
