- Expect major impacts to terrain in the area of Canyon Lodge and Roller Coaster (4) due to construction and events. They should be considered parking and access to the mountain only.
- Expect limited services at Canyon Lodge over the weekend. Eagle Lodge is currently closed, we will evaluate conditions for a potential re-open on Memorial Day Weekend.
