Town Council Meeting Items - January 3

- Town Council will consider approving an agreement between the Town of Mammoth Lakes and Mammoth Lakes Housing (MLH) providing \$2.2 Million in funding for the Access Apartment Project.
- Town Council will consider adopting an update to Chapter 8.15 of the Town of Mammoth Lakes Municipal Code to prohibit single-use plastic water bottles of 500ml or less at Town-affiliated events, including events that require a special event permit, effective January 1, 2025, and will prohibit any business from selling or distributing single-use plastic water bottles of 500ml or less within the Town of Mammoth Lakes, effective January 1, 2026. If adopted the Ordinance shall become effective and enforceable thirty (30) days from and after the date of its adoption.
- Town Council will vote to waive the reading and adopt by title only the ordinance adopting Municipal Code Chapter 10.24 regarding vehicles on Trails (e-bikes, bikes and other related transportation devices).
- Town Council will consider authorizing the Mayor to a sign letter of support for Whitebark's Grant Request to the Cal Fire Forest Health Program.
