Town Council voted to approve by Resolution the Appropriations Limit, Investment Policy, and Annual Town Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-25. Town Council also approved the Town of Mammoth Lakes Fiscal Year 2024-25 Master Fee Schedule.
- Town Council provided consensus draft Ballot Language for a proposed 2% Transient Occupancy Tax Increase and provided direction to staff regarding the Lease to Locals Program.
