



## ***SAVE THE DATE - The Parcel Ribbon Cutting and Groundbreaking Ceremony: August 7***

- The Town of Mammoth Lakes in partnership with Pacific West Communities, Inc. is celebrating the opening of "The Sawyer" – Phase 1 of The Parcel affordable housing project and the groundbreaking for "The Kingfisher" – Phase 2 of The Parcel.
- The [opening celebration](#) will take place on **Wednesday, August 7 from 12-2pm** at The Parcel Park. Attendees are encouraged to arrive to the site via public transit (Purple Line from the Town Park N' Ride), bicycle, or by foot, as public parking will be limited.
- The community is cordially invited to attend the festivities that will feature speeches, complimentary food and drinks hosted by the Mammoth Lakes Police Department, tours of The Sawyer, playground, and childcare facility, and informational booths from the project partners highlighting their involvement in this much-needed community project and the services being provided.

## ***DID YOU KNOW that every two years the Town of Mammoth Lakes holds an election to elect members to the Town Council?***

- This year's municipal election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. Two Town Council seats will be on the November ballot.
- The nomination period for members of the Town Council is from **July 15 to August 9, 2024**, with the potential to be extended to August 14, 2024 if any of the two incumbents do not run for Town Council again.

## ***Road and Multi-Use Path (MUP) Rehabilitation Project Update***

- Beginning on Tuesday, July 30, crews will pulverize, grade and compact Mono Street and Dorrance Drive in preparation for paving the following week.
- Motorists can expect delays and/or detours as work continues through August. Please review the [project map](#) for additional information and the roads/MUPS impacted by this work.
- Re-paving of the multi-use paths along Old Mammoth Road and the Mammoth Creek Park Playground is expected to begin on Monday, July 29 and be completed by Wednesday, July 31.
- Please be aware that while this work is being done, detours will be in place along Old Mammoth Road and the playground will be closed for safety. Please respect the closure signs and stay off the playground equipment. The Mammoth RecZone will operate as per schedule.
