Mammoth Lakes Police Department Establishes New Chief’s Advisory Committee

- A new Chief’s Advisory Committee (C.A.C.) is being created to act as a resource for the Chief in the formation of strategies, development of community policing concepts, and increased public awareness. The committee is intended to provide a forum for discussions concerning community issues and the goal is to have a broad spectrum of viewpoints represented.
- The Chief’s Advisory Committee will be led by the Chief of Police or his/her chosen Chairperson. Members of the Chief’s Advisory Committee will be selected from a pool of Mammoth Lakes community members and will serve either a renewable one-year or two-year term.
- Regular meetings will be scheduled monthly in the afternoon to early evening hours. This time may change based upon the needs of the Chief’s Advisory Committee. The intention of the Chief’s Advisory Committee will be to meet in person.
