

Mammoth Lakes Community Dog Park Now Open!

- The first-ever community dog park in Mammoth Lakes is now open! The off-leash dog area is located on land owned by the Mammoth Lakes Foundation at 190 College Parkway and is approximately one acre in size. It includes a 5-foot perimeter fence, with a double-entry gate system and separate small and large dog areas.
- The dog park features 5,000 square feet of custom dog turf, 4 benches and access to water. Leash posts are coming soon. Parking is available for approximately 40 vehicles, and a restroom with water fountains and bottle filling stations is onsite.
