Town Council Meeting Action Items - November 20, 2024

- Town Council received the pre-audit actual financial presentation for Fiscal Year 2023-24 and adopted the resolution amending the FY2024-25 budget as recommended by the Town Manager. Amendments to the budget included: \$1,350,000 for future capital (MACC construction), \$1,000,000 for the Housing Now! Small Site Development Program, \$1,300,000 to the Housing Now! Small Site Development Program from the Mammoth Lakes Tourism Reserve, \$1,200,000 for the Housing Now! Small Site Development Program Housing Reserve, \$145,000 to send three police recruits to the police academy, \$75,000 for a landscaping contract, \$125,000 to fund airport equipment, and \$2,300,000 from the Transit Reserve to help fund 6 large buses operated by ETSA operating in the Town of Mammoth Lakes.

Winter Storm Warning Posted for Mammoth Lakes

- <u>NWS Reno</u> issued a <u>Winter Storm Warning</u> for Mammoth Lakes above 7,000 feet in effect from 4:00pm Friday to 10:00pm on Saturday. Snow accumulations of 10 to 18 inches with isolated amounts up to 2 feet is forecast with 30 to 40 mph Southwest winds with gusts up to 65 mph. Ridge wind gusts may reach up to 125 mph.
- For the <u>Winter Storm Watch</u> from Sunday to Tuesday, 4 to 8 inches below 7,000 feet is forecast with 1 to 3 feet possible above 7,000 feet.
