Local Youth Sports Organizations Get a Hand Up!

- In today's busy world, it is more important than ever that all kids have the opportunity to participate in organized sports. Sports help develop confidence, social skills, teamwork and resilience, in addition to benefiting a child's physical and mental health.
- This is why, at the beginning of each calendar year, the Town of Mammoth Lakes and Mono County award valuable funding to local, non-profit youth sporting organizations. The youth sports funding process takes place with oversight and funding recommendations from the Town's Parks and Recreation Commission. The majority of funds are used by the youth sporting groups as scholarships to foster greater participation from low-income families. Additionally, funds are used for travel expenses, uniforms and equipment.
- This year, \$47,000 was awarded by the Town Council to local youth sports organizations that serve more than 950 children from Bridgeport to Crowley Lake.
- Recipients included Mammoth American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO), Disabled Sports Eastern Sierra (DSES), Eastern Sierra Nordic Ski Association (ESNSA), Mammoth Club Volleyball, Mammoth Lakes Futbol Club, Mammoth Lakes Swim Team and Mammoth Lakes Youth Hockey (MLYH).
- To be eligible for funding an entity must be registered with the State of California as a non-profit organization, directly provide an organized sports program that serves youth between the ages of 3-18 yrs., offer a consistent and structured opportunity for play to large groups of children, have limited funding sources and/or support low-income households and actively volunteer at Town events. The Town and County are proud to make a difference in the lives of our local youth!
