



Town Council Meeting Action Items – May 21, 2025

- The Town Council awarded a contract for The Parcel Phase 3 Infrastructure Design.
- The Town Council reviewed and commented on restricted revenue funds, housing and capital project funds that will assist staff in preparing the next phase of our FY25-26 budget process.
- The Town Council awarded contracts for three capital improvement projects that will take place this summer: 2025 Slurry and Fog Seal project, 2025 Road and Multi-use Path Rehab, and Miscellaneous Concrete and Facility Work project.

Mammoth Lakes Basin is OPEN!

- The Lakes Basin (Lake Mary Road) opened to vehicle traffic this morning, May 23 at 7:00 a.m.
- Campground openings have been delayed until June 6 due to snow levels. However, Twin Lakes Campground will be open this weekend!
- Most trails and areas around the lakes are still covered in snow, so be prepared for winter conditions. Picnic areas and day use site access will be limited.
- Fish stocking took place in the Lakes Basin today!
- The Parks Maintenance crew have been hard at work clearing the Multi-Use Paths (MUPs) in the Lakes Basin. The section between the Twin Falls Overlook and Horseshoe Lake is still closed due to snow, however warmer temperatures over the next week should help with ongoing snow removal.

The Police Department reminds all visitors and residents to please keep safety in mind while enjoying Mammoth Lakes:

Driver Safety

- Be aware of the pedestrian crosswalks on Main Street & Old Mammoth Road.
- Be courteous to bicyclists and give ample room when passing.
- The sun is powerful at higher elevation, never leave children or pets in unattended vehicles, even if the outside temperature feels reasonable.

Bicycle Rider Safety

- Obey the rules of the road – stop at red lights and stop signs, use hand signals, etc.
- Wear a helmet and bright-colored or reflective clothing while riding.
- Ride with traffic, never against it.
- Bicycle lighting is required at night.
- Bicyclists must use the bicycle lane when on a roadway equipped with such lanes and the bicyclist is moving slower than the normal speed of traffic.

Pedestrian Safety

- It's dark at night in Mammoth Lakes - Do not assume drivers can see you.
- Pedestrians do not automatically have the right-of-way.
