- Town Council recognized the retirement of Building Inspector/Plans Examiner Ron Haskins.
- New Police Officers James Clark, Emily Leach and Rodolfo Madera were introduced to the Town Council, participated in the oath administered by the Town Clerk and received their Police Officer badges.
- Town Council participated in a joint workshop with the Board of Mammoth Lakes Tourism to discuss the Economic Impact Study, Summer Stewardship, and Winter Air Service.
- The California Department of Fish and Wildlife provided a Summer Update to the Town Council.
- Town Council approved the letter of public comment from the Town Council regarding the proposed reorganization of the United States Forest Service, approved the resolution authorizing the second amendment to the professional services agreement with DTA for the preparation of a Development Impact Fee and Housing Fee Nexus Study, adopted an Ordinance renewing the Town's Military Equipment Use Policy, and adopted a resolution rescinding the approval of Use Permit (UPA) 23-002 and vacating the CEQA Notice of Exemption for the construction of an 80-foot tall "stealth monopine" cell tower located at 1574 Old Mammoth Road.
