Town Council Meeting Action Items – November 5, 2025

- Town Council approved an additional \$7.2M in gap funding for the Kingfisher 2 affordable housing project at the Parcel subject to certain conditions and adopted a Resolution approving the Third Amendment to the Solid Waste Services Agreement between the Town and Mammoth Disposal related to rate adjustments. Town Council voted to provide up to \$100,000 of financial support for emergency food assistance for CalFresh recipients and adopted a Resolution in support of Public Lands to ensure protection and proper management by our Federal Partners.
