CONSTRUCTION VEHICLE PARKING AND TEMPORARY STORAGE OF MATERIALS IN TOWN RIGHTS-OF-WAY

The following are conditions of your construction permit and apply to the parking of construction vehicles and the storage of building materials in the Town right-of-way:

- 1. All materials, including dumpsters, shall be stored a minimum of two (2) feet behind the line of the snow stakes.
- 2. Such materials storage shall be of a temporary nature for the purpose of building construction only.
- 3. All material storage shall not interfere with the free movement of public traffic or pedestrians and shall not interfere with the Town's snow removal operations.
- 4. When material is being loaded or unloaded, flagmen shall be used for traffic control at all times.
- 5. All materials shall be properly barricaded and lighted and/or otherwise marked to protect the traveling public and pedestrians, as well as be visible for snow removal operations.
- 6. Materials shall only be stored on a site with an active building or grading permit. Material may not be stored in front of or on adjacent properties.
- 7. Materials shall be stored or stacked in a manner so they will not create any hazard or endanger life or property.
- 8. Vehicles may only be parked on one side of the street.
- 9. Vehicles may not park on the street when snow removal is taking place. Any vehicles hampering snow removal operations will be subject to a citation and towing.
- 10. Vehicles shall not park in a manner that would hamper access for emergency vehicles.
- 11. All vehicles shall be parked in a manner so that they will not create a safety hazard for other vehicles by obstructing line of sight to the roadway.
- 12. Portable toilets shall be stored at least ten (10) feet behind the line of the snow stakes.
- 13. The Town right-of-way may be used by the Town for snow storage. Any materials or equipment in the right-of-way may be subject to being buried in snow. Snow storage extends ten (10) feet beyond the snow poles.
- 14. The Town of Mammoth Lakes will not be responsible for damage to any materials, vehicles, or equipment stored or parked in the right-of-way.
- 15. All areas where materials have been stored shall be cleaned and restored to at least as good of a condition as the right-of-way was prior to construction.
- 16. Authorization to store materials in the Town right-of-way or park vehicles on Town roads between November 1st and April 30th may be revoked at any time.
